### **Skyline Enterprises invests \$14 million to Skyline Luge Sentosa**

- *Two new tracks and a new Skyride added to enhance ridership experience*
- *Celebrating with the local community: \$15,400 worth of tickets for charity, promotions for residents till end 2017*

Diversified tourism company Skyline Enterprises announced a \$14 million update for Skyline Luge Sentosa, the group's first Luge in South-east Asia. Riders can look forward to the addition of two new Luge tracks and a new Skyride to enhance the ridership experience and reduce waiting time.

To celebrate the additions with Singapore, Skyline Luge Sentosa will set aside 700 tickets (worth S\$15,400) for local charities and community organisations. Local residents can also enjoy \$3 off the 4 Luge & Skyrides combo (usual price: \$28 per pax) from now till the end of the year.

"The Skyline Luge Sentosa is our first Luge in Southeast Asia. Set in this beautiful landscape with both greenery and the beach in Sentosa, the attraction stands proud as one of the best-loved experiences in Singapore. The boost in infrastructure will mean shorter waiting time, a wider variety of options, and generally more fun for everyone," said Mr. Danny Luke, General Manger International Luge, Skyline Enterprises.

### **A Stronger Focus on Fun: A New Skyride and Tracks for a Local Adventure Like No Other**

To date, the Skyline Luge Sentosa has hosted over 13 million rides. Riders can take the Skyride up to the starting point of the Luge. They can then hop onto the Luge for a unique wheeled full-filled gravity ride which provides riders full control over their descent on a purpose-built track and is safe for all ages.

At the Imbiah Station starting point of the Luge, riders can take their pick among a variety of Luge tracks. In addition to the existing Jungle and Dragon trails, riders can dive into the two new brand Luge tracks that twist and turn through the mystical forest. Specially designed with hairpin corners, long straight and exciting slopes, riders can now look forward to an experience to remember with their family and loved ones as they zoom down the four tracks (2.6 km in all). The new tracks are the 658 metre long Expedition and 638 metre Kupu Kupu, which means "Butterfly" in Malay. The names are from a contest where Skyline Luge Sentosa fans and supporters submitted suggestions.

The Skyride will offer a scenic free-top adventure on a 4-seater chairlift. Spanning across 315 metres, the new Skyride gives riders a bird's eye view of Sentosa, the Singapore city skyline and the South China Sea of up to 16 metres above ground. Riders can look forward to enjoying the breeze and feeling the wind on the 7 to 9 minutes long Skyride in mid-air.

### **Celebrating with Singapore – Giving (Fun) Back to the Local Community**

To celebrate the launch of the new tracks and Skyride, local residents can enjoy \$3 off 4 Luge & Skyrides combo (usual price: \$28 per pax) from now till 31<sup>st</sup> December 2017. They can enjoy the promotion by flashing their Identity Cards at the Skyline Luge Sentosa's ticketing counter for verification purposes. Each resident is entitled to one redemption.

Skyline Luge Sentosa will also be setting aside 700 tickets (2 Luge + Skyride Combo) worth up to \$15,400 to local charity and community organisations.
