Our company, as the PCBU, are required under the “Health & Safety at Work (Asbestos) Regulations 2016” to complete an Asbestos Survey of each of our buildings and then implement an Asbestos Management Plan.

A requirement under the regulation is to ensure that any contractors and their staff working on a Skyline Property are informed of where any asbestos, ACM (asbestos containing materials) or ACD (asbestos contaminated dust) may be. This information can be found in the Asbestos Management Plan which is available on our website or by request from the Property Team.

As a PCBU we must ensure that our contractors have the knowledge, systems and procedures in place (relating to the type of work their company carries out) to work safely in each of our buildings when near to, or working with, known asbestos contaminated materials.

The type of work that your company undertakes will be asbestos related work only, and in no way do we expect you to undertake any asbestos removal work at any time.

Asbestos related work could be something that your company does in your general day to day work, but that work would be carried out in proximity to, on to, fixed to or penetrates a product that contains asbestos.

As the PCBU, when we engage you to undertake any work on our site we are to inform you of any possible interaction that you or your staff may have with asbestos contaminated materials prior to you starting on site.

- When working on, near or around asbestos contaminated materials, we confirm that our company are implementing systems and procedures that mitigate the risks relating to asbestos.
- Should we ever need to undertake asbestos related work on a Skyline property, that being work on, near or around asbestos contaminated materials, in conjunction with the PCBU we will develop a task analysis, SSSP and/or procedure to manage the risks associated with said undertaking.
- Should a concern arise in relation to the contractors task analysis, SSSP and/or procedure and the risks in respect to the asbestos contaminated materials, then an asbestos assessor may be asked to review and help manage the risks before starting this work.
